RAMPING UP TO ALGEBRA (MATH GRADE 8)

<u>Time:</u> 10:00 - 11:55

Cost: \$120

8th Grade Mathematics focuses on pre-algebra skills involving/including The Number System, Expressions and Equations, Functions, Geometry, and Statistics and Probability. Throughout the school year, the goals of this course are to make students make sense of problems and persevere in solving them, reason abstractly and quantitatively, construct viable arguments and critique the reasoning of others, model with mathematics, use appropriate tools strategically, attend to precision, look for and make use of structure, and look for and express regularity in repeated reasoning. A solid skill-set entering 8th Grade Mathematics is to be a precise and consistent equation solver, be able to follow procedures (both simple and complex) repeatedly, analyze and interpret real-world problems with mathematical modeling, and be a student/mathematician that can, and will, persevere independently. Throughout this summer session, we will focus on solving linear equations, graphing linear equations, working with graphs, and other basic skills needed to be successful in 8th Grade Mathematics..

ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS SKILLS MYSTERIOUS EVENTS (GRADES 7-8)

THE 60'S: A TURBULENT DECADE IN AMERICAN HISTORY (GRADES 8 - 9)

This course will trace the events surrounding one of the most turbulent decades in American history. Students will examine issues surrounding he Cold War including the Cuban Missle Crisis and the Vietnam War. We will look at how the mood of the country changed wit the assassination of President John F. Kennedy and will also look at the cultural revolution that defined the 60's, analyzing music from the time period from the Beatles, the Rolling Stones, Neil Young, and Jimi Hendrix, among others. Lastly, we will look at the "Space Race" that culminate with the moon landing in July of 1969.
